He made tens of thousands of dollars of purchases via our other payment processor, then either wanted refunds days later or his parents disputed the charges. It cost us a lot of money in fees that weren't refunded to us. We were finally able to block him via their platform but now he's processing cards through paypal checkout instead. Twice I've had customers receive their orders (delivery confirmation), contact PayPal and the say they didn't authorize the purchase, and PayPal issued them a refund from my account. They kept the merchandise and got their money back. After about 3 or 4 weeks, I received the money again in my account from ONE of them. PayPal reversed their decision. Anyway, now I have an international customer that orders from me but every order he receives he complains about. He used to be an ideal customer; ordering lots of stuff and always happy. Then one day he complained that something was broken and he wanted the part to fix it. I sent him an entire new item, and he thanked me over and over. After that, every order he received he complained about - missing or broken parts, etc. After the 1st one I packed all his orders myself and triple checked all the items. He still complained, but I knew there was no

problem. Finally I told him to send me pictures of the broken parts, or return them and I'd refund him. He didn't do that, but continued to complain. So, I stopped shipping to him completely. Every time I see a payment from him, I refund it. I just have a bad feeling that he's going to figure out that PayPal will give him anything he wants and I'll get burned bad. The problem is that I'm not the only one who processes our orders. Some day one of his orders will get through. I'd like to be able to block his name, address or email address. What's to stop someone from purchasing 10 times and opening disputes on all of them and hurting your Paypal reputation.
